Providing standards to guide employment of U.S. military forces

Doctrine provides authoritative guidance and standardized terminology on topics of relevance to the employment of military forces.

It enhances the operational effectiveness of, and helps to unify, all branches of the military.

*The President's Unified Command Plan assigns the USJFCOM with the responsibility of supporting the Chairman's joint doctrine program, including providing recommendations to the Chairman for the development, assessment, distribution, and maintenance of joint tactics, techniques, and procedures, as well as doctrine publications.

JWFC oversees the joint doctrine development processes, identifies and resolves key doctrinal issues, and evaluates and validates joint doctrine once it is developed.
